we may **boldly say**, The Lord is **my helper**, and I will **not fear** what man shall do unto me."-Hebrews 13:5-6

O Act on the faith that God will take better care of His children than the best of human parents can care for their children.

Right now-as urgently as we would call out for the lifeguard if we were drowning-we should ask Jesus to be our Savior and Lord.

If you have trusted Christ as your Savior, this advice will help you become a *strong* Christian:

- 1. **Follow** Jesus Christ by studying and obeying the Bible, I Peter 2:2.
- 2. **Pray** for guidance, protection, and for power to be obedient,
 Philippians 4:6–7.
- 3. **Go** to an active, Bible teaching church on Sundays to worship and serve God with other Christians,
 Hebrews 10:25, Acts 2: 1–47.
- 4. **Tell** others every day about Jesus and His wonderful gift of eternal salvation, Acts 2:47.



• Know how to pray so we know for sure God is listening.

"We know that God heareth not sinners: but if any man be a worshipper of God, and doeth his will, him he heareth." -John 9:31

First thing, God's will is that you be saved from the penalty and power of sin. "God our Saviour . . . will (wills to: wants to) have all men to be saved, and to come unto the knowledge of the truth."-I Timothy 2:3-4 "The Lord is...not willing that any should perish, but that all should come to repentance." -2 Peter 3:9

Then, "If ye abide in me, and my words abide in you, ye shall ask what ye will, and it shall be done unto you." -John 15:7.

Simply listen to God, and God will listen to you.
